BY THE LORDS OF HER MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE  
PRIVY COUNCIL

WHEREAS section 124A(3) and (4) of the Education Reform Act 1988(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") provide that the Privy Council may by Order make an instrument of government of any higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect, and that the said instrument of government shall comply with the requirements of Schedule 7A to the Act and may make any provision authorised to be made by the said Schedule 7A and such other provision as may be necessary or desirable:

AND WHEREAS the Coventry University higher education corporation is a higher education corporation with respect to which the said Schedule 7 has effect:

NOW, THEREFORE, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by the said section 124A(3) are pleased to, and do hereby, make an instrument of government for the Coventry University higher education corporation as set out in the Schedule to this order, which shall come into force forthwith.

*SCHEDULE*

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING ORDER

1. INTERPRETATION

(1) In this Instrument the following words and expressions shall have the meanings indicated in this paragraph:

"the Act" means the Education Reform Act 1988 as amended from time to time;

"the Corporation" means the Coventry University higher education corporation;

"the Board of Governors" means the members of the Corporation;

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

## BETWEEN

COVENTRY UNIVERSITY, of Priory Street, Coventry, CV1 5FB, United Kingdom and  
GOKULA EDUCATION FOUNDATION, of MS Ramaiah Nagar, MSRIT Post, Bangalore 560 054,  
India

## WHEREAS

- 1 Coventry University offers a broad range of study programmes at undergraduate, postgraduate and higher degree level

## WHEREAS

- 2 Gokula Education Foundation together with Coventry University wishes to deliver Coventry University's MSc programmes in Information Technology for Manufacture, and Engineering and Manufacturing Management, in India

## WHEREAS

- 3 the parties are desirous of developing their existing relationship towards establishing, subject to contract, joint programme arrangements, a staff and student exchange programme, and a collaborative research and development programme

## WHEREAS

- 4 the parties have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to facilitate initial confidential discussions in pursuance of clause 3 above


## NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS


- 5 The substance of the discussions between the parties to this Memorandum shall remain confidential and shall only be disclosed to a third party by prior agreement between the parties including without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, all course material for the Coventry University MSc programmes.
- 6 Throughout the duration of this Memorandum the parties shall not enter into discussions of a similar nature to those outlined in 3 above with a third party.
- 7 The parties shall use all reasonable endeavours to conclude their preliminary discussions by 31 August 1999 with the aim of entering into formal legally binding agreements in pursuance of clause 3 above as soon as possible thereafter.
- 8 Either party may terminate this Memorandum by giving notice in writing, and the Memorandum shall terminate forthwith save that the provisions of clause 5 shall continue for a period of 2 years beyond the date of termination.

- 9 Neither party to this Memorandum shall have the right to assign transfer charge sell or otherwise deal in its rights and/or obligations under this Memorandum.
- 10 This Memorandum sets forth the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and no modification of any of the terms of this Memorandum shall be effective unless and until the same have been made in writing and signed by the parties hereto by their duly authorised officers.
